SUBJECT: **SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON REVISITING THE K-12 CURRICULUM: ENHANCING CONTENT AND PEDAGOGY FOR EFFECTIVE LANGUAGE TEACHING-LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES**

DATE : May 11, 2018

1. To further improve the quality of language teaching and learning practices of elementary and junior high school teachers of English and make the curriculum more fit to the diverse Filipino learners in the country, this Office shall conduct a three-day live out seminar-workshop on **Revisiting the K-12 Curriculum: Enhancing Content and Pedagogy for Effective Language Teaching-Learning Opportunities** on May 29-31, 2018, at San Matias HS (for Junior HS Teachers) and San Matias ES (for Elementary English Teachers).
2. The seminar-workshop specifically aims to:
 - a. revisit the key features of the K-12 Enhanced Basic Education Curriculum (EBEC) such as the Learning Standards – Content and Performance Standards, Learning Competencies and Learning Objectives;
 - b. evaluate/Assess the appropriateness of the competencies, strategies and pedagogies used/applied per grade level;
 - c. create lesson exemplars, lesson plans, instructional materials, interventions and activities based on assessment of feedbacks; and
 - d. model effective strategies through demonstration teachings.
3. Participants in the seminar-workshop are the 100 select Junior High School English teachers and 66 Elementary English teachers.
 - a. The Training Matrix and the complete List of Participants shall be released through a division memorandum after the planning meeting with the Trainers, PETA/DASSET Officers which is set on May 15, 2018, 8:00 A.M. at the teacher's Training Center, DepED, Division of Pampanga, CSFP.
4. Participants are requested to bring the following reports which will be used in the crafting of instructional materials and interventions:
 - Elementary –consolidated district List of three (3) Least Mastered skills from Grades 1-6 per grading period.
 - Junior HS – list of three least mastered skills from grades 7-10 per grading period
5. Expenses which include food and training kits shall be charged against the Division MOOE Funds. Meanwhile, all other expenses incidental to the seminar-workshop are chargeable against local school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
6. Participants shall be entitled to a three-day service credits pursuant to DO No. 53, s. 2003 following all the set guidelines and requirements.
