As part of our Division's continuing support to the DepEd's *Every Child a Reader Program*, which aims to make every Filipino child a reader and a writer at his/her grade level, this Office shall conduct an orientation of select teachers on the *POLICY GUIDELINES IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING INVENTORY (PHIL-IRI)* on June 29, 2018 at 8:00-10:00 A.M, Teachers' Training Center, Division Office, CSF, Pampanga.
2. Participants in the said orientation are the District English and Filipino Coordinators and one (1) School Head, in-charge of Reading per district which will be identified by the PSDSs.
