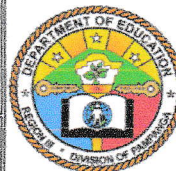

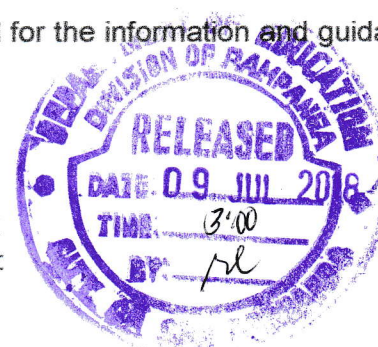
Subject: **CAPACITY BUILDING FOR INDIGENOUS PEOPLE COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES ENGAGED WITH DEPED IN CURRICULUM CONTEXTUALIZATION**

Date: July 02, 2018

1. The engagement with IP elders, culture bearers is an essential aspect of curriculum contextualization, as highlighted in the Indigenous Peoples Education (IPED) curriculum Framework (DepEd Order No. 32, s.2015). The need to capacitate those who are engaged with DepEd in the process of curriculum and learning resource development has been an emerging concern in various program implementation discussions both within DepEd and with IP representatives and civil society partners. Relative to this, the Division of Pampanga will conduct Capacity Building for Indigenous Peoples Community Representatives Engaged with DepEd in Curriculum Contextualization on July 25- 27, 2018 at the Redd Manor Hotel, City of San Fernando.
2. The training-workshop aims to:
 - 1) familiarize community representatives with the rationale and current developments in DepEd's IP Education Program
 - 2) level-off on DepEd's policies, processes, procedures, mechanisms, structures relevant to implementing IP Education
 - 3) develop a platform of collaboration that would harmonize perspectives, policies and programs, rights and duties, as well as roles and functions of the different participating institutions for IPED implementation

 - 14 – IP Elders/Culture bearers
