

SUBJECT: **ORIENTATION OF GRADE 7 ENGLISH/FILIPINO TEACHERS ON THE POLICY GUIDELINES IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING INVENTORY (PHIL-IRI)**

1. As part of our Division's continuing support to the DepEd's *Every Child a Reader Program*, which aims to make every Filipino child a reader and a writer at his/her grade level, this Office shall conduct an orientation of select Grade 7 English and Filipino teachers on the *POLICY GUIDELINES IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING INVENTORY (PHIL-IRI)* on July 13, 2018 at 1:00-5:00 P.M, Teachers' Training Center, Division Office, CSF, Pampanga.
2. Each Junior High School is required to send one (1) participant, either a Grade 7 English or Filipino teacher.
3. There will be no registration fee. Travel expenses of the participants shall be charged against Local School funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
4. Participants are requested to bring hard copies of the Revised Phil-IRI manual (preferably the part intended for Grade 7) which will be used during the orientation. Printing cost of said manual shall be charged against the school MOOE funds or from other local school funds.
5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is earnestly desired.
