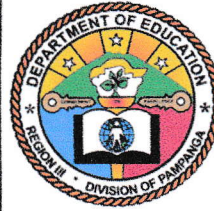

1. One of the goals of the K-12 Basic Education Program is to develop learners' competencies, work ethics, and values relevant to pursuing further education and/or joining the world of work. Work Immersion is, thus, a requirement for graduation. Learners are immersed in actual work environments such as workshop offices and laboratories in which their prior training is relevant.
