**Subject:** **DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON CONTEXTUALIZING THE ARLING PANLIPUNAN CURRICULUM FOR INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION (IPED)**

**Date:** October 29, 2018

1. The Enhanced Basic Education program, as stipulated in Republic Act 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec.8.4), mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive, contextualized and flexible enough to enable and allow schools to localize and indigenize teaching and learning materials based on the social context of indigenous cultural communities (ICCs).
2. In support of this mandate, the Division of Pampanga will conduct the **Division Training-Workshop on Contextualizing Araling Panlipunan Curriculum for Indigenous Peoples Education (IPED)** on November 26-28, 2018 at the Bliss Hotel, Lazatin Boulevard, City of San Fernando, Pampanga
3. At the end of the training-workshop, participants are expected to develop a holistic perspective on the overall learning and socio-cultural context of ICCs. In particular, participants are expected to gain and develop competencies needed in contextualizing the curriculum responsive to ICCs being served, and the competencies needed in developing Araling Panlipunan lesson plans based on the contextualized curriculum for IPED.
