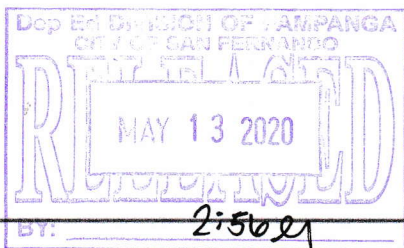

CONDUCT OF SUMMER REMEDIAL CLASSES FOR LOWER GRADES SY 2019-2020

TO : Chiefs of Functional Divisions
 Heads of Units
 Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads
 All Others Concerned

1. Per DepEd Memorandum No. 51, s.2020 titled Guidelines on the Conduct of Remedial, Advancement and Enrichment Classes During Summer 2020, SDO Pampanga announces that schools may conduct Remediation Classes starting May 18, 2020, for lower grades.
2. Conduct of Summer classes is generally six (6) weeks, four (4) hours per subject, but schools may opt to shorten it when the essential learning competencies have already been attained by learners.
3. School Heads are required to submit the prescribed requirements as stipulated in the previous Division Memorandum No. 148, s. 2020 to the CID Office before the conduct of the activity.
4. It is highly encouraged that no Face to Face instruction will be conducted to failing students in lower Grades but more on online and modular instruction. School heads need to identify learners with internet connectivity, who can attend online instruction with the assigned teacher, and for those without internet connection, may avail of self-instructional modules in subject area/s where learners failed. Provisions of Division Memorandum No. 146, s. 2020 and Division Memorandum No. 148, s. 2020 shall also be followed.
5. Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) will share Strategic Intervention Materials (SIMs) in the Local portal LIBRU of SDO Pampanga and these can only be accessed if DepEd email-addresses of School Heads shall be shared/notified to Sir John Palasigui for the sharing of Google links. Moreover, teachers can also access materials thru <http://commons.deped.gov.ph>. Teachers are also highly encouraged to prepare other materials which can greatly help in the attainment of the identified not mastered competencies of learners.
6. Immediate dissemination and strict adherence with this Memorandum to all concerned is earnestly desired.




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
